These questions are intended to inspire thought and recollection for group discussion and are not an all-inclusive list of discussion points.

- Does the book title, For Such a Time as This, have any significance to you?
- Do you find the title relevant or meaningful after reading the book?
- Would you change the title? If so what would you name it?
- How would you describe the main theme or purpose?
- What passages or quotes stood out to you?
- What did you like most, and least about the book?
- How did the book make you feel? Did it bring to memory places the ideas in this book may have helped you, or someone you know?
- What was the author's goal? Did the author achieve his goal?
- What new ideas were the author presenting? How did you feel about that?
- What did you learn from reading this book? Is it something you'll practice?
- Did the author seem authoritative in the subject of platform or prayer?
- Have you read other books similar in message or theme?
- Which person's story moved you, or impacted you the most?
- What was your favorite chapter and why?
- What surprised you most about this book?

- Do you see places in your life where you can use this?
- Have any of your personal views changed because of the book?
- Where there times you wondered about the author's point?
- Is this in line with your beliefs? Has it changed your perspective about prayer?
- Will you read the author's fictional works?
